

The Event will be held from 28th September 2025 to 5th October 2025, under the rules and regulations of **Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI)**.

ARTICLE 2. TYPE OF EVENT

The Event is a UCI ProSeries race, entered on the UCI Asia Calendar and registered as a Class 2.Pro event. The Event is open to athletes of the Men's Elite and Men's Under-23 categories. In conformity with Article 2.10.008 of the UCI Regulations, points are awarded as follows:

Based on the final results of the individual general classification:

ARTICLE 3. PARTICIPATION

As per Article 2.1.005 of the UCI regulations, the event is open to the following teams: UCI WorldTeams (65%), UCI ProTeams, UCI Continental Teams, UCI Cyclo-cross Professional Teams and National Teams.

As per Article 2.2.003 bis of the UCI regulations, teams must be formed of six (6) riders and may not start with less than four [4] riders.

The fact of entering and/or participating in the Event implies that each team fully accepts all the provisions laid out in these Specific Regulations and undertakes to respect them.

LICENSE AND JERSEY CONTROL

Team representatives are requested to confirm their starters and collect their race numbers from 1445hrs - 1645hrs on 27th September 2025 at Aquamarine Room, Bayview Hotel Langkawi, Kedah. Managers are kindly reminded to bring along their riders' and sporting directors' 2025 licenses, as well the 2025 team jersey.

TEAM MANAGERS' MEETING

The Team Managers' Meeting, organised in accordance with Article 1.2.087 of the UCI Regulations, in the presence of the Members of the Commissaires' Panel, is scheduled for 1700hrs on 27th September 2025 at Aquamarine Room, Bayview Hotel Langkawi, Kedah.

OPENING CEREMONY

The Opening Ceremony is scheduled at 2045hrs on 26th September 2025, at Dataran Lang, Langkawi. It is mandatory for riders to attend, wearing race attire with sport shoes. Further details will be made available upon initial check in by teams at Langkawi.

PRE-RACE SIGNING ON

Riders will be expected to sign on before each stage **as a team**. A daily schedule will be issued by Communique.

ARTICLE 5. RADIO-TOUR

Race information will be broadcast primarily in English on the Radio Tour channel. Radio receivers will be provided and installed in team's race circulation vehicles.



ARTICLE 6. NEUTRAL SUPPORT

The neutral support service will be handled by Le Tour de Langkawi Neutral Service, by means of three [3] Cars and two [2] motorcycles.

Please note that all mechanical service must take place on the left side of the road.

ARTICLE 7. FINISHING TIME LIMIT

The finishing time limits for Stages 1, 2, 4, 6, 7 and 8 will be 12% of the winners' time, and for Stages 3 and 5 it will be 20%. The time limit may, in exceptional circumstances, be increased by the Commissaires' Panel in agreement with the organiser according to Article 2.6.032 of the UCI Regulations.

Further, in case riders actually out of the time limit are given a second chance by the President of the Commissaires' Panel, all points awarded in the general classifications of the various secondary classifications shall be withdrawn.

ARTICLE 8. RACE INCIDENTS IN THE LAST 3 KILOMETERS AND STAGES EXPECTED TO FINISH IN A BUNCH SPRINT

The 3km rule (Article 2.6.027 of the UCI Regulations) will apply to all stages, except on Stage 5 from Temerloh to Fraser's Hill, where the finish is designated as being at the top of a hill climb.

The following stages have also been identified as being 'expected to finish in a bunch sprint' (sprint zone starts at 3 km to-go sign): Stages 1 / 2 / 3 / 4 / 6 / 7 / 8

During these stages, the Sprint zone protocol for stages "expected to finish in bunch sprints" published on the UCI website in the Regulations section will be applied and the time gap calculation shall apply as provided for the protocol.

ARTICLE 9. FEEDING

As per Article 2.3.027 of the UCI Regulations, feeding may be taken from team vehicles after 30km from the actual start and up to 20km before the finish, behind the car of a Commissaire or as otherwise indicated by a Commissaire.

The Commissaires panel may reduce the distances mentioned above depending on climatic conditions and race situation. Such decisions will be communicated to the Team Managers before the start of a stage, or on Radio Tour.

Please note feeding in the Feed Zones will be on **the left side of the road** only. Pursuant to Article 2.3.025 of the UCI Regulations, all team personnel carrying out feeding in a Feed Zone must be licensed and wear team clothing. Feeding outside of the designated Feed Zones of each stage shall be prohibited.

Litter shall be discarded in accordance with Article 2.2.025 of the UCI Regulations.

Litter or Waste Zones will be organised at the 30km point, before and after each Feed Zone and at the 20km to go point. There will also be additional Waste Zones indicated in each Stage itinerary.

Penalties will be applied for non-compliance in accordance with Article 2.12.007-8.3 of the UCI Regulations.

There is an escorted Feed Convoy that leaves 15 minutes before the Start of every Stage.

ARTICLE 10. CLASSIFICATIONS

The following classifications will be issued:

- a. Individual general classification on time,
- b. Individual general classification on points,
- c. Individual general mountains classification (King of the Mountains),
- d. Individual general classification on time for an Asian rider,
- e. Team classification on time, and
- f. Team classification on time for an Asian team.

10.1 Individual general classification on time

The individual general classification on time is decided by adding together the time taken by the riders on each stage, less any time bonuses and plus time any penalties. In the event of equality in time, the leading rider will be decided in accordance with Article 2.6.015 of the UCI Regulations.

The leader of this classification will wear the **PETRONAS Green Jersey**.

In accordance with Article 2.6.019 of the UCI Regulations, time bonuses are awarded as follows: At the Stage finish:

Bonus seconds	10"	6"	4"



At an intermediate sprint:

Position	1	2	3
Bonus seconds	3"	2"	1"

10.2 Individual general classification on points

The individual general classification on points is decided by adding together the points earned by a rider at each intermediate sprint and for all Stage finishes, except the finish at Stage 5 from Temerloh to Fraser's Hill, where no points will be awarded.

Points are awarded as follows:

At the Stage finish:

The daily leader of this classification is the rider with the most points accumulated at the end of each Stage. In the event of an equality of points, the leading rider will be decided in accordance with Article 2.6.017 of the UCI Regulations.

The leader of this classification will wear the KBS Orange Jersey.

10.3 Individual general mountains classification (King of the Mountains, KOM)

The individual general mountains classification is decided by adding together the KOM points earned by a rider at each designated climb in the Event.

Points are awarded as follows:

At the summit of a Category 1 climb:

At the summit of a Category 2 climb:

The daily leader of this classification is the rider with the most KOM points accumulated at the designated climbs at the end of each Stage. In the event of an equality of KOM points, the leading rider will be decided in accordance with Article 2.6.017 of the UCI Regulations.

The leader of this classification will wear the MSN Polka Dot Jersev.

10.4 Individual general classification on time for an Asian rider

The leader of this classification is the highest placed rider in the individual general classification by time at the end of each Stage who is licensed by a Member Federation of the Asian Cycling Confederation

The leader of this classification will wear the RAKAN MUDA White Jersey.

10.5 Team classification on time

The team classification on time is decided on the basis of the sum of the three [3] best individual times from each team, excluding time bonuses. In the event of an equality on time, the leading team will be decided in accordance with Article 2.6.016 of the UCI Regulations.



10.6 Team classification on time for an Asian team.

The leading team of this classification shall be the highest placed team in the team classification on time that is registered as a UCI Continental Team in, or National Team of, a Member Federation of the Asian Cycling Confederation. The team shall also have at least three (3) Asian riders in the starting line-up to qualify and the times of the best three (3) Asian riders from the team shall be taken into account for this classification. In the event of an equality on time, the leading team will be decided in accordance with Article 2.6.016 of the UCI Regulations.

ARTICLE 11. LEADERS JERSEYS

The wearing of Leaders Jerseys is mandatory for the Signing On.

If a Rider is leading more than one Classification, the order of priority of the distinctive jerseys shall be as follows:

- a. Individual general classification on time (PETRONAS Green Jersey);
- b. Individual general classification on points (KBS Orange Jersey);
- c. Individual general mountains classification (MSN Polka Dot Jersey);
- d. Individual general classification on time for an Asian rider (RAKAN MUDA White Jersey).

In this situation, the Organiser will require another rider next on the relevant classification to wear a jersey which is not being worn by the leader of that classification. However, if this rider must wear his World, Continental or National Champion jersey, he shall wear that jersey.



ARTICLE 12. OTHER DAILY PRIZES

12.1 Best ASEAN rider

A prize for the Best ASEAN rider shall be awarded daily, the winner for which shall be the rider with a license issued by a national federation of an ASEAN (Association of South-East Asian Nations) member country and who is the highest placed in the individual general classification for that day.



12.2 Most combative rider

A prize for the most combative rider shall be awarded daily, the winner for which shall be determined by a special jury and announced at the conclusion of each Stage. The criteria for this prize shall include overall combativity demonstrated by consistency and effort of attacks, time spent in a breakaway and positive sportsmanship, among others. Decisions of the special jury for this prize are final.

ARTICLE 13. PRIZE MONEY

A grand total of 166,860 Euros will be awarded in prize money at the event. Prizes shall be paid to the beneficiaries or their representatives no later than 90 days after the finish of the race. Article 1.2.073 of the UCI Regulations shall apply for any dispute.

The Organiser will transfer the said prize money into a specific bank account as part of a centralized platform for the distribution of prizes and managed by the UCI or a third-party designated by the UCI. The detailed table of prizes is on **page 166.**

ARTICLE 14. ANTI-DOPING

The UCI anti-doping regulations are entirely applicable to the event. Riders and Team Officials must check and be aware whether they are required for any daily anti-doping controls. Doping controls will take place after the finish of each Stage at a location indicated in the Race Manual, close to the Finish Line.

ARTICLE 15. AWARDS CEREMONY AND PROTOCOL

The following riders must attend the official awards ceremony after each Stage Finish:

- The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed riders on the Stage,
- The rider designated as Most Combative Rider of the Stage,
- The rider designated as Best ASEAN Rider of the Stage.
- The leaders of the following classifications:
 - Individual general classification on time for an Asian rider (RAKAN MUDA White Jersey)
 - Individual general mountains classification (MSN Polka Dot Jersey)
 - Individual general classification on points (**KBS** Orange Jersey)
 - Individual general classification on time (PETRONAS Green Jersey)



These riders must present themselves at the podium no later than ten (10) minutes after crossing the finish line.

From Stage 2 onwards, before each Stage start, the jersey holders/wearers will be presented to the public on the front row of the start line, prior to the ceremonial start.

FINAL STAGE AWARDS CEREMONY

At the completion of the final Stage (Stage 8), the following riders must present themselves at the final awards ceremony at the Kuala Lumpur City Centre Finish Line:

- The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed riders on the Stage.
- The rider designated as Most Combative Rider of the Stage, The rider designated as the Best ASEAN Rider of the Stage,
- The winners of the following classifications:
 - The 1st placed team in the Asian team general classification and their team manager,
 - The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed teams in the team general classification and their team managers,
 - The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed riders of the individual general classification on time for an Asian rider.
 - The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed riders of the individual general mountains classification,
 - The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed riders of the individual general classification on points,
 - The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed riders of the individual general classification on time.

ARTICLE 16. PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

ARTICLE 17. TEAM VEHICLES

All teams will be provided with two [2] cars (equipped with cycle racks for four [4] bicycles on each rack) and two [2] passenger vans. The Organisation trusts the Teams to keep the vehicles tidy and clean throughout the Event. Teams are not allowed to affix any form of advertisement or branding on the team vehicles provided by the Organiser, without prior permission. For the avoidance of doubt, any damage to team vehicles from the installation of any advertisement or other equipment shall be charged to the team.

Both team cars will be allowed to circulate within the Race convoy, provided both drivers hold the relevant UCI license. All foreign drivers should be in possession of an International Driving Permit.



Fuel and any necessary toll payments will be at the cost of the Organisation. All race vehicles MUST be refuelled only at PETRONAS service stations.

Drivers of team vehicles are expected to adhere to the instructions of the Royal Malaysian Police officers while in Race circulation and to obey all Malaysian traffic laws at all other times. Non-compliance with any traffic law may result in law enforcement action for which the driver concerned shall be solely responsible.

Any incidents of collision or crash involving the team vehicles, whether in or out of the Race, must be reported immediately to the Transport Manager. All fines and penalties imposed shall be at the cost of the driver concerned.

ARTICLE 18. RESULTS

Daily Classifications and Results will be issued by email every evening, and physical copy will be provided upon request by any team. Please ensure your email addresses have been given to the Secretariat.

ARTICLE 19. CYCLING AND THE ENVIRONMENT

The Organiser would like to remind all parties involved in the race to be sensitive to environmental concerns. As over 70% of the Race Route will pass through primary and secondary forested areas, the environmental impact of the Event must be minimized.

The Organiser will ensure sufficient waste bins and portable toilets at each Start and Finish area, as well as Waste Zones for riders throughout the Race route.

There will be strictly no littering at all staging areas, hotel car parks, start/finish venues, feed zones and throughout the Race route. All refuse is to be disposed in a responsible and hygienic manner. Penalties will be applied for failures to comply.

Please be reminded that causing deliberate damage to flora and fauna along the Race route is strictly prohibited and may incur penalties.

ARTICLE 20. ETIQUETTE AND IMAGE

Teams are politely reminded that while Malaysia welcomes all visitors warmly, the prevailing local culture is generally conservative and Muslim-oriented, and Teams are requested to be mindful of this at all times.



The Organiser reserves the right to refuse participation or to exclude from the Event any Team or individual Team members whose actions or conduct damages the Event's image and/or reputation, including:

- A breach of Malaysian law, whether deliberately or through gross indifference,
- Acts of physical aggression to any person in or outside the race, or
- The public wearing of indecent attire or display of inappropriate behaviour.

ARTICLE 21. HEALTH AND MEDICAL SUPPORT

Medical care during the Race shall be provided by the Malaysian Armed Forces Health Services Division, by way of two [2] race doctors, one in a following vehicle and one on a motorcycle, and two ambulances with paramedics.

In the event an emergency evacuation of a rider or team member becomes necessary, the medical team shall make the on-site assessment and send the patient to the nearest public hospital emergency room for treatment and/or admission.

The Organiser shall provide a medical clinic at the primary hotel of each Stage, the specific location of which shall be notified at the lobby of the said hotel.

ARTICLE 22. RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSS AND/OR DAMAGE

Teams are requested to note that while the organiser aims to provide a comfortable and safe environment in and out of the race for everyone, each team will be held financially responsible for:

- Any loss and/or damage to the property of the organiser or any other third party if it is determined that a team member was responsible for such loss or damage, or
- ii. The incurring of any cost with any third-party service provider without the organiser's prior written permission.

This includes, but is not limited to, the following:

REGARDING ACCOMMODATION

- a. Hotel keycards or other hotel property not returned upon checkout,
- b. Physical damage to any hotel property or facilities caused by a team member,
- The take up of any additional hotel rooms beyond the agreed number contained in the team's enrolment form.
- d. Any chargeable in-room services, including meals or laundry,



REGARDING VEHICLES

- e. Lost vehicle kevs.
- f. Damage to radio equipment or roof racks provided with the team vehicle,
- g. Physical damage to the team vehicle, including damage to vehicle accessories or equipment, that necessitates replacement of any part or any form of extensive repair or repainting, as well as the cost of towing where necessary,
- Spillage of any liquids within vehicles that necessitates replacement of the vehicle's accessories
 or other form of extensive specialist cleaning,
- Use of the wrong type of fuel for the vehicle that necessitates draining of the fuel tank, as well as the cost of towing where necessary,
- The take up of any additional vehicles beyond the agreed number contained in the team's enrolment form.

REGARDING OTHER EQUIPMENT

- k. Lost, unreturned or damaged bicycle transponders,
- I. Lost, unreturned or damaged neutral service bicycles, and
- m. Other lost, unreturned or damaged equipment that was provided to teams by the organiser.
